**BY THE NUMBERS: GROWING  
IMPACT**

This year, 450 new patients have turned to Woven Health Clinic for care, joining the many who already rely on us for their health needs. Together, this has added up to over 6,800 patient visits so far in 2025—a clear sign of both the growing need in our community and the trust people place in us to provide compassionate, whole-person care. Every visit represents a life touched, a story supported, and a step toward better health.

The expiration of Affordable Care Act (ACA) subsidies is projected to cause more than 1.1 million Texans to lose health insurance coverage, with lower-income adults most vulnerable to dramatic premium increases (Kaiser Family Foundation [KFF], as cited in Texas Tribune, 2025). Dallas already faces one of the nation's highest uninsured rates, and these changes could leave tens of thousands more without access to affordable care—further straining the capacity of clinics, hospitals, and safety-net providers (KFF, as cited in Texas Tribune, 2025).

While recent federal budget changes will bring uncertainty for many families relying on Medicaid and ACA subsidies, our mission remains clear: to ensure no one is left without care. We are committed to being a safety net and a source of stability during times of transition.

The stress of repeated job rejections only deepened her sense of disconnection.

Over time, Angie began experiencing depression and anxiety, even struggling with thoughts of suicide. That's when she turned to ***Woven Health Clinic's Mind Matters Wellness Program***. Through a combination of medication and counseling, Angie found a safe space to share her struggles. In therapy, she explored the pressure she felt to succeed far from home and learned to recognize her emotions as a natural response to a major life transition.

With support, Angie gradually built healthier routines, reconnected with peers, and began envisioning new possibilities for her future. Today, she has gained clarity, self-compassion, and the courage to take her next steps forward.
